

Wounded Warriers



On Saturday, May 10th, ten members and spouses from the Virginia Peninsula Rotary Club got together at David Miller's dental office to pack "comfort kits" to send to wounded soldiers. When soldiers in Iraq and Afghanistan are wounded, they are sent directly to Ballad Air Force Base in Iraq for stabilization, until they can be sent home. Many times, the wounded are transported directly without

any of their personal items or toiletries. The Wounded Warriors Comfort Kits project supplies those basic items to soldiers in a time of need. This wonderful project, organized by Keith Bales, had tremendous support from our club. Cathy Miller worked with Keith to get donations of money and items to help our Nation's wounded warriors. The comfort kits included t-shirts with the Rotary logo, a variety of toiletries, blankets, phone cards, underwear, and flip flops. Also sent was a book of letters from the children at the Riverside Behavioral Health Center and a variety of other books and magazines. In May of 2007, a GSE team from Kent visited District 7600 in connection with Jamestown 400 followed in June by a visit from seven Rotarians to the Tidewater area in the first half of the Friendship Exchange.

Disaster Relief

District 7600 is implementing an emergency disaster relief plan for situations such as the tornado tragedy in Suffolk or hurricanes such as Isabel. Assistant District Governor Bob Harper recently gave us an update on the district plan which basically plugs Rotary clubs into an existing network of "Volunteer Organizations Active in Disasters." Rotary will provide resources including volunteers and funds to appropriate local organizations to aid in disaster relief. Tywana German, the Suffolk Director for the United Way and a member of the Suffolk Rotary Club, reports that 451 homes had been damaged with 145 no longer habitable. District Governor Jim Pierce reports that Rotary clubs in District 7600 have given or pledged \$15,000 for disaster relief in Suffolk. As part of this effort, our club's board approved a donation of \$1000.
